

#### Lent Madness: A Unique Lenten Devotional

Lent is a sacred time of preparation, penitence, self-reflection, and renewal, but there is no need to be dreary as we prepare with joy for the Paschal feast. Taking our faith seriously, but not ourselves, is the essence of Lent Madness. Lent Madness is a fun, engaging way for people to learn about the men and women who have inspired generations of Christians. What we learn from these Saints is that they, like us, are flawed human beings through whose lives, Christ's love shone brightly. If this love can shine brightly in their lives, perhaps we too can be beacons of the Good News. Like us, their vision may not have



been perfect, and they had their share of blind spots, but what binds them together is a strong faith in Jesus and a willingness to serve him amid the circumstances of their own day. Along the way, we'll learn from them and be inspired by them and see Jesus a bit more clearly through them.

#### How Does it Work:

- 32 "pre-selected" Saints are placed in a tournament-style, single-elimination bracket (similar to March Madness).
- Reconcilers can choose a saint, and create posters that "advertise" their saint, in the hopes of their saint being chosen as the best of the best!!
- Brackets will be filled out and turned in no later than February 26.
- Voting will begin on February 27 and this a nationwide vote. Each pairing remains open to vote on for 24 hours, and people will vote online at www.lentmadness.org daily for their favorite saints.
  - 16 Saints will make it to the Saintly Sixteen
  - 8 Saints will advance to the Elate Eight
  - 4 Saints will make it to the Faithful Four
  - 2 Saints to the Championship
  - And the winner is awarded the coveted Golden Halo
  - Voting will take place daily from February 27-April 8

#### There are 4 ways to participate:

• Choose a saint from a pre-selected list. Create a poster that "advertises" your saint (why should your saint be chosen as the "best of the best.") All posters are due to Jennifer Murphy no later than February 23.


Don't choose a saint and don't make a poster, instead participate in filling out a "bracket." Saint posters will be displayed and brackets will be handed out on February 23 in Brown Hall. All you will need to do, is walk around and "visit" everyone's posters. Decide which saints you think will move on to win the coveted Golden Halo. Fill out your bracket and hand it in to Jennifer Murphy no later than February 26. The trifecta: Choose a saint, make a poster and fill out a bracket!!! West has received numerous awards in national exhibitions. He has works in the permanent collection



of the McNay Art Museum in San Antonio, and the collections at Texas A&M University and the University of Louisville (which recently honored him as a Hite Scholar with an exhibition of his paintings). He is a member of the prestigious "Watercolor Gang." His work and articles about him have appeared in many national publications including "Artist's Magazine", "American Artist Magazine", and "Who's Who in American Art".


